<b>Role title:</b>	Youth support worker/ Play Ranger
<b>Purpose of the role:</b> What difference will you make?	WCC's Youth Service has a varied offer which aims to meet young people where they are, responding to needs and helping to support, signpost and generally make being a young person in Woughton a more positive experience.
<b>Key tasks/activities:</b> Will you be working in a team? What does it involve? What specific tasks will be undertaken? Is it working with clients and, if so, who are they?	You will work as part of a team and will always have a lead Youth Worker present to support you in your role. Dependent on the project, you may play games, chat, do craft activities, play sports with young people or help young people to access other services or advice they need.
<b>Key skills, experience and qualities needed:</b> The key attributes needed to be a success in this role.	Different skills are needed for the different projects: perhaps gaming, sports, dance, music, art etc but in all projects Volunteers must have a desire to support young people and enjoy their company.
<b>Days and times required:</b> Is this a one-off or regular opportunity? How much time is needed to make a difference? Is it flexible?	Projects run between 3-7pm week days in term time and during the day in school holidays
<b>Location of role activities:</b>	Across the Woughton Area
<b>Minimum age of volunteers:</b> Is this role suitable for 16 to 18-year-old learners?	16
<b>Support offered:</b> Details of training, ongoing supervision, expenses, etc	All volunteers will be supervised and will have opportunities to access role specific training for free. All will receive in-house youth support role training.
<b>Other useful information:</b> Minimum commitment required, if a DBS will be needed	A DBS will be needed and will be sorted by WCC Safeguarding lead
